Strand I: Reading: Standard K.1.3: Genre and Structure: The students will read, listen to and discuss a variety of genre.

Read Across America via videoconference annually in March. K-2 classes across the U.S. are partnered with each other.

TWICE

*Any time of year, partner Kindergarten classes read to each other a book such as *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom* and choral read it together via videoconference.*

Ask your distance learning coordinator to help you find a partner class.

Strand I: Reading: Standard K.1.4: Issues and Themes: The students will demonstrate an understanding of issues and themes by making connections within and across texts.

*Partner K classes plan a celebration of a pattern book such as *If You Give a Mouse a Cookie*. Partner classes choral read the book together, and then read their adaptations/new versions of the book to each other.*
